TITLE: Community Relations

BOARD MEETINGS

All meetings of the Gilmer County School Board are open to the public and are announced in advance. Only emergency meetings may not be announced in advance. Special meetings may be called by the President or any three members, but no business shall be transacted other than that designated in the call.

Executive sessions may be held only upon a majority affirmative vote of the members present as defined in Open Governmental proceedings 6-9A-4 of the WV Code.

The minutes of each board meeting are compiled and a copy is sent to newspapers and all of the county schools. Additional information is provided to the news media staff, students, and public as often as possible.

Official board meetings of the Gilmer County Board of Education are scheduled on the second and (fourth) Mondays of each month. Each session convenes at 7:00 p.m., and adjourns after all relevant and appropriate actions and discussions have been completed.

Points of business fall, generally, under approval of minutes, bills, budget supplements, hearing of public, employment, and other related business. Every effort will be made to advertise any changes to this announced procedure.

The Gilmer County Board of Education will meet annually with local school improvement councils (LSIC) to provide opportunity for input and to establish a cooperative working relationship.
