TITLE: Alternative Education Programs

Policy 2418

The establishment of alternative education programs is essential to provide a safe and orderly learning environment and to meet the educational needs of disruptive students and those who have been unsuccessful in the traditional classroom.

Alternative educational placements will be determined by individual schools with consideration for staff and financial constraints. Options may include, but not limited to, detention, in-school suspension, out of school suspension or separate alternative classroom.

Gilmer County Schools will participate in the Alternative Education Program at Calhoun-Gilmer Career Center. Criteria for student selection and placement will be determined by the career center Administrative Council.
