Calculating the Grade Point Average

A. Grades 9-12

All classes taught at Gilmer County High School meet each day for one period. The grade point average of students is to be calculated by assigning the appropriate quality points to each grade assigned (A-4, B-3, C-2, D-1, and F-0) total the numerical value and divide by the number of grades received to obtain an average.

Example: Physical Education	B	=	3
Algebra	A	=	4
Biology	B	=	3
Typing	C	=	2
English	B	=	3
TOTAL			15

AVERAGE 15 / 5

3.0 Grade Point

Students attending The Career Center attend three periods a day. The grade they receive will be weighted to reflect three periods; Welding B-3 (3 x 3 periods = 9 Total).

B. Grades 5-8

The grade a student receives in the courses listed will be weighted as indicated to determine their eligibility to participate in extracurricular activities.

Students are to receive grades in each subject.

C. Honor Roll

1. Grades 9-12

Honor roll will be calculated as it has in the past. Classes which count for graduation but do not count for honor roll are as follows:
Band, Choir, Gifted or Accelerated, Journalism, Physical Education and Career Awareness.

2. Grade 5-8

For honor roll purposes a school will use the weighted grades in Reading, English, Spelling, Science, Math and Social Studies.
