A. Grades 5-6

The grade a student receives in the courses listed will be weighted as indicated to determine if they made the honor roll (3.0).

Students are to receive grades in each of the following subjects.

B. Grades 7-12

Student grade point averages are calculated on all classes each grading period for honor roll purpose (3.2). Classes assigned as Advanced Placement or Honors have the following grade point assignment: A=4.5, B=3.5, C=2.5, D=1.5, F=0. All other courses have regular grade point averages, A=4, B=3, C=2, D=1, F=0. The following courses have weighted grades.
