Title: BEGINNING PRINCIPAL INTERNSHIPS

Gilmer County Schools will provide a beginning principal internship program that includes an orientation program, release time for the mentor and beginning principal to meet, and documentation within the current evaluation system. The county superintendent will assign the mentor based on mandated guidelines including five years of administrative experience in a related position, training as a mentor, and that the mentor is not responsible for the evaluation or supervision of the beginning principal intern. The mentor will be compensated with a six hundred dollar stipend by the West Virginia Department of Education for these services.
