

TITLE: Uniform Health Record Policy
State Board of Education Ref: 16-3-4

Effective at the beginning of the 1981-82 school year, Gilmer County adopted the uniform health record card for the following categories of pupils:

1. All pupils enrolling in kindergarten and prekindergarten programs.
2. First graders who did not attend kindergarten.
3. All transfers from other schools.

If Gilmer County desires to use another health card, one must request an exception from the State Board of Education. However, the State Board will not approve a local health record that does not contain the data required by the state adopted uniform health record.

The State Department of Education, in conjunction with local educational agencies and the State Department of Health, will review the uniform health record every five years to determine appropriateness of data and need for revision. The first review will occur during the 1981-82 school year. (4/11/81)
