

TITLE: Public Access to Public Information
State Board of Education Ref: S6-9A-5; S29B-1-3

Gilmer County School allows access to public information according to state statues (6-9A-5 and 29B-1-3).

Each governing body shall provide for the preparation of written minutes of all of its meetings. All such minutes shall be available to the public within a reasonable time after the meeting and shall include, at least, the following information: (1) date, time, and place of the meeting; (2) The name of each member of the governing body present and absent; (3) All motions, proposals, resolutions, orders, ordiances and measures proposed, the name of the person proposing the same and their disposition; and (4) The results of all votes and upon the request of a member, the vote of each member, by name.

Every person has a right to inspect or copy any public record of a public body in this State by making a request to the custodian of the official records. All requests for information must state with reasonable specificity the information sought. The custodian of the record shall honor all reasonable request that do not violate exemptions under State Code 25B-1-4.
